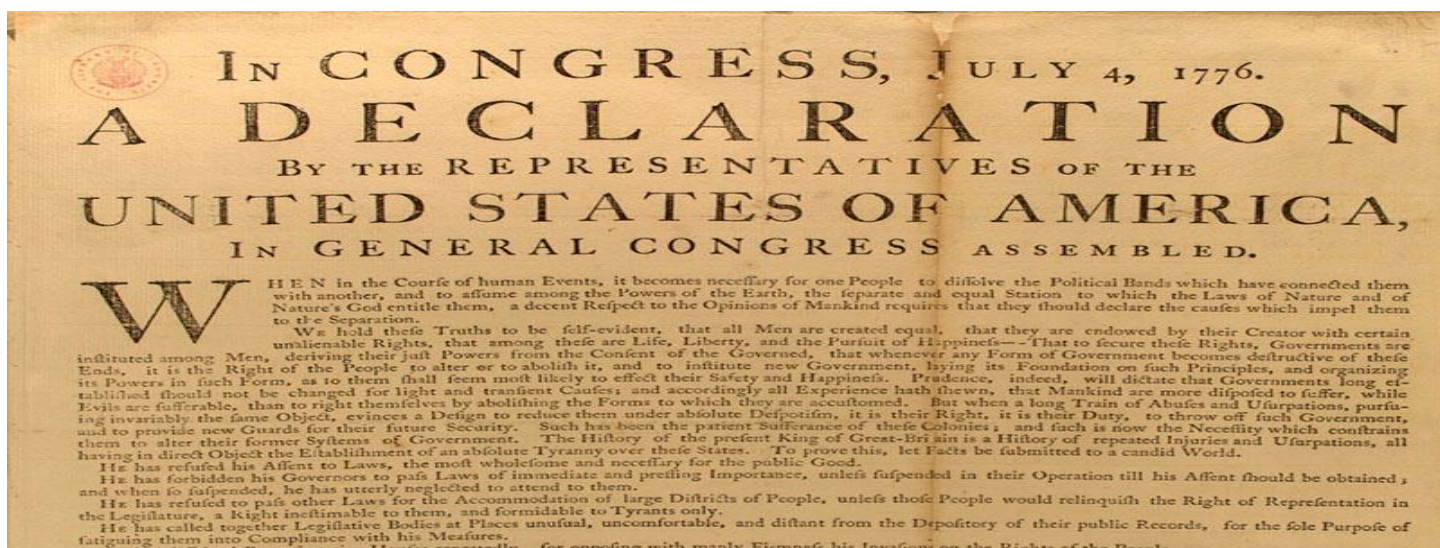


COLONIAL AND EARLY AMERICA
