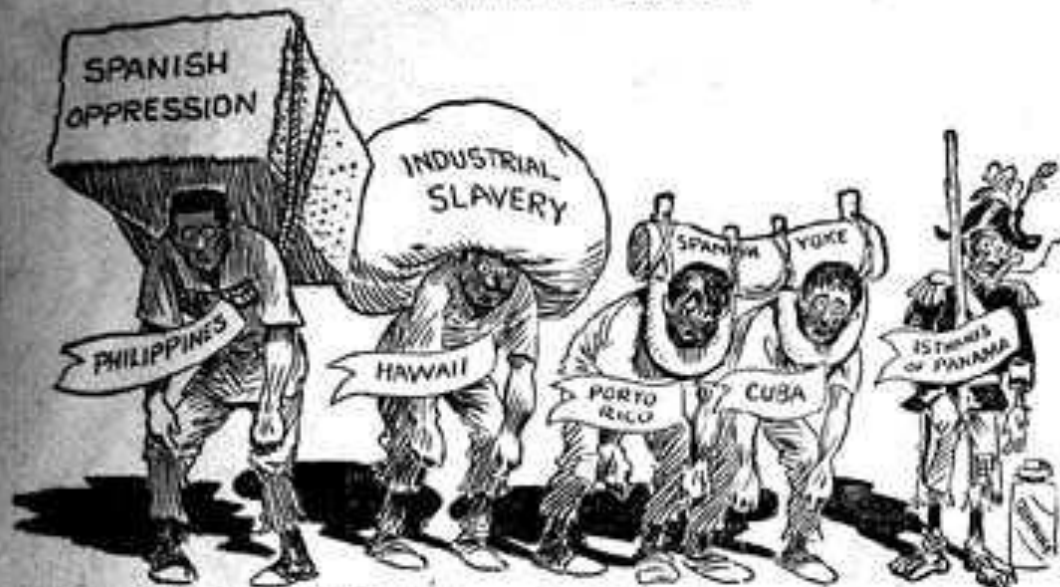
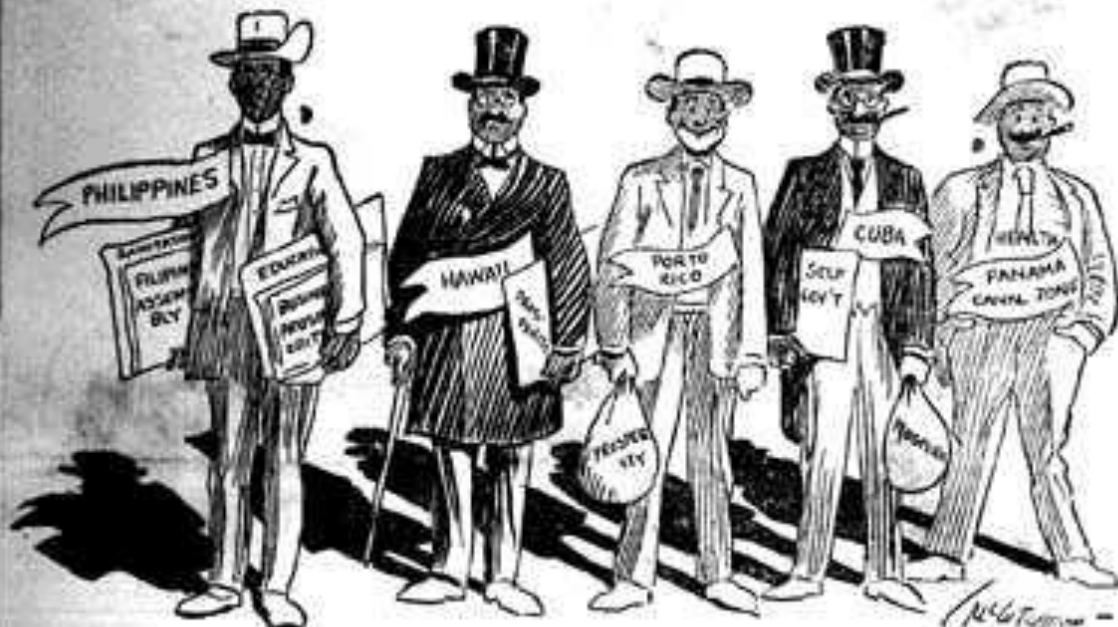

Before the United States intervened in behalf of these oppressed people.

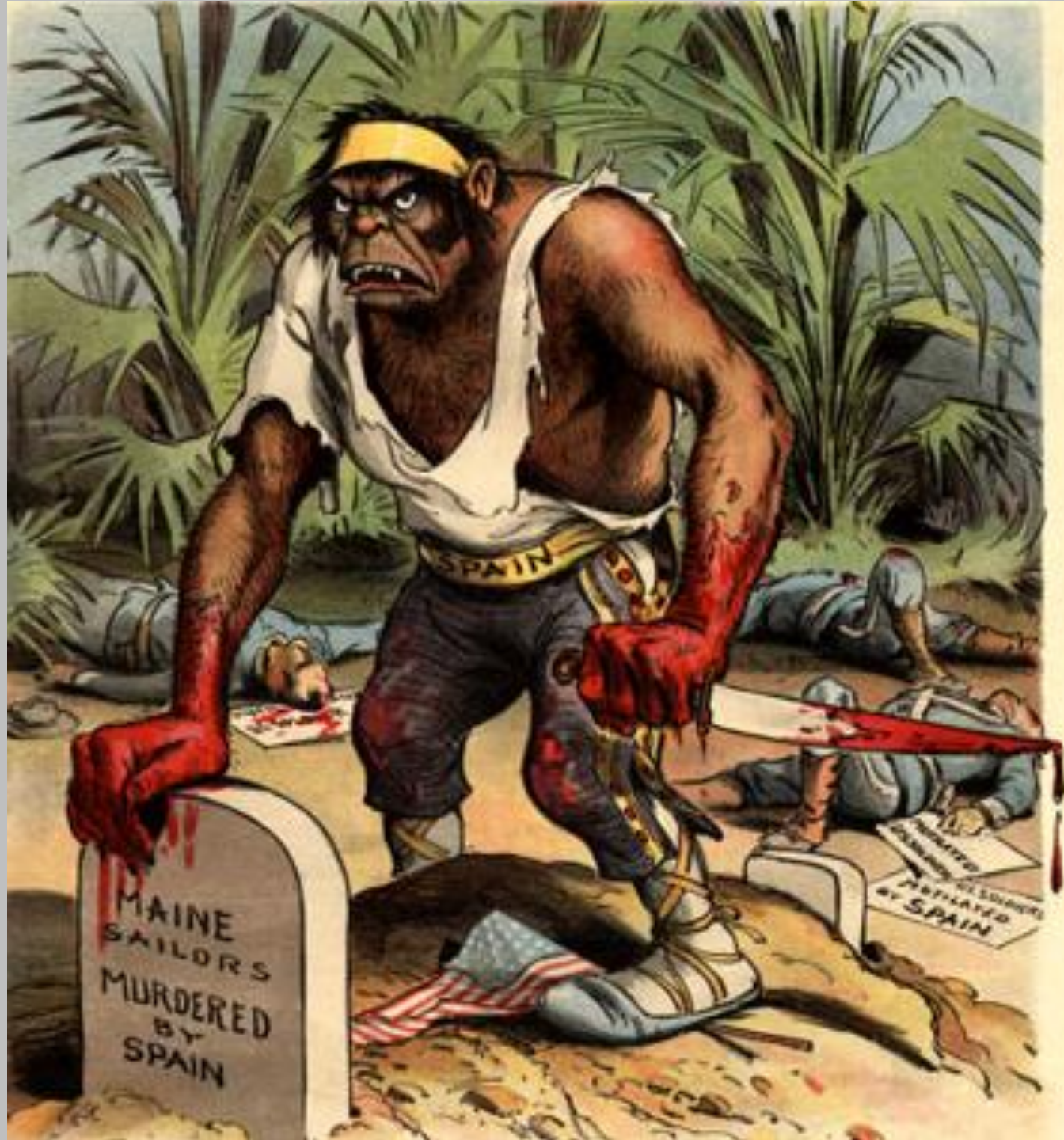


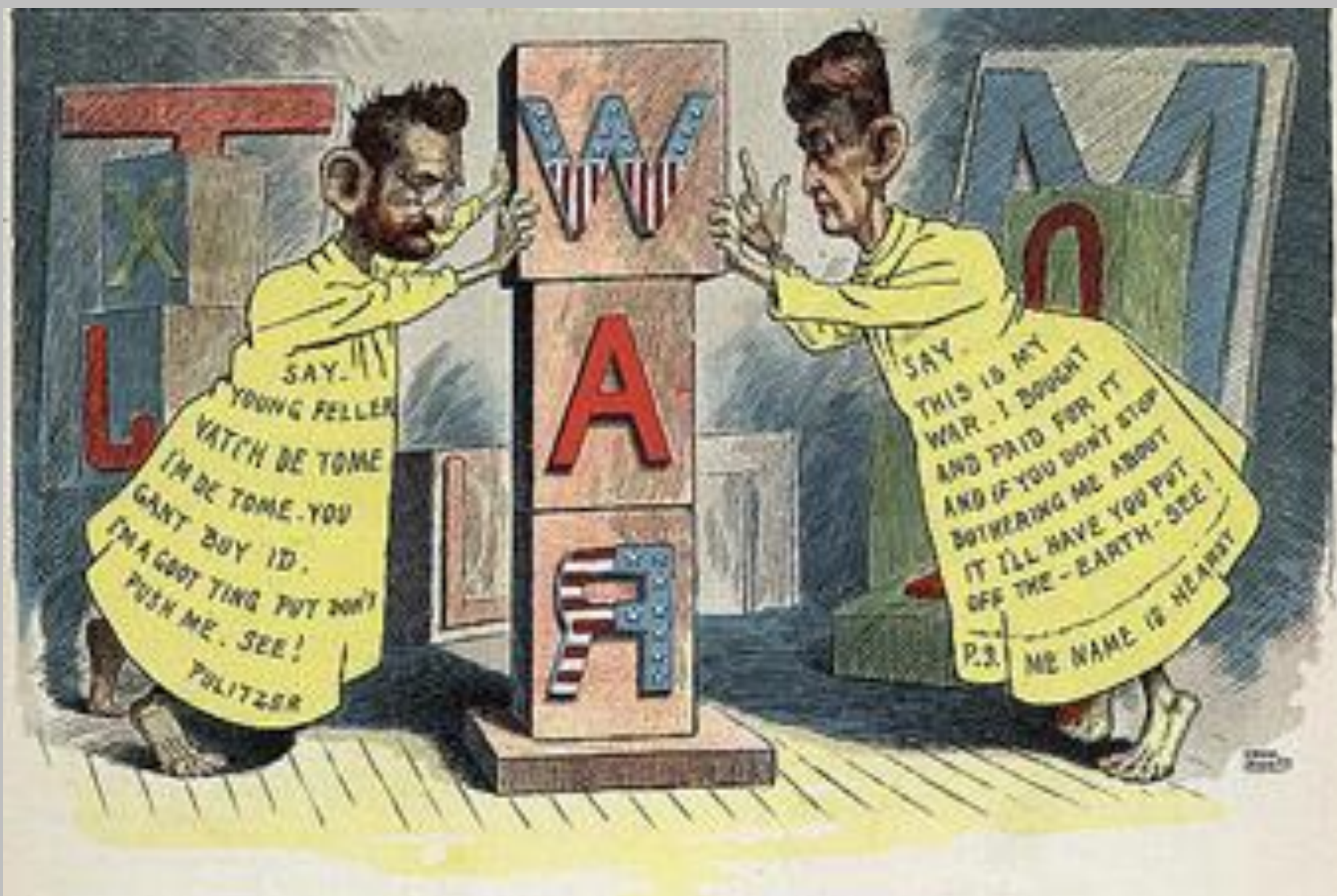

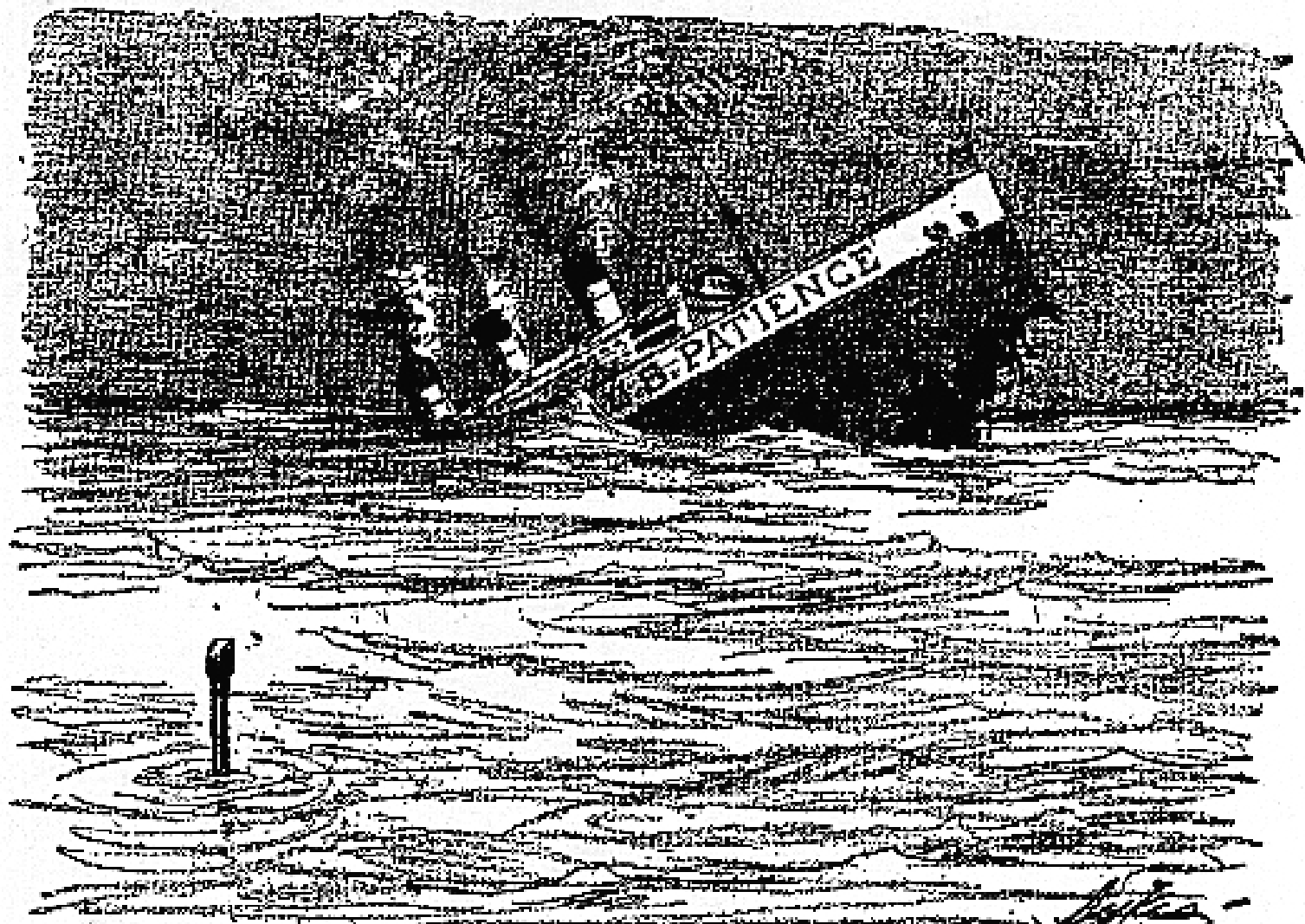
